The issue of a license means that swimmers, coaches and parents can assume that the meet is a “quality competition” which complies with a standard set of requirements. Each Swimmer’s results will be registered and stored on the ASA database.

1. The Club Championships will be held under ASA laws and regulations and ASA technical rules of racing and in accordance to the ASA open meet criteria. All events will be timed finals. The overall champion and age group placing will be decided by the times achieved (See over sheet for further details).
2. The Competition will be held in a 5 lane, 25 meter deck level pool with anti -wave lane ropes. Over the top starts may be used at the referee’s discretion.
3. Heats will be swum with all age groups combined and swimmers seeded by entry time. All events will be spearheaded. If you require an entry times please speak to your coach and we will endeavor to arrange a time trial.
4. Entry Fee will be £8.00 for 8U’s, £15.00 for 9 to12 Years and £15 for 13/Over plus £2.00 administration charge. This will include a medal for everyone that takes part and will be presented at the Presentation Evening on Friday 21ST October @ Queens Hall Halstead.

Closing date for entries – Midnight on Friday 29TH July 2016

You may only enter into one age group. Age @ 7th October.

Please only enter the events that you intend to swim on the day.

In the event of a withdrawal that is deemed unjustified by the management team, the swimmer may be excluded from competing in further rounds of the 2016 Club Champs.

5. These are your Club Championships and provided that you have been a bona fide first claim member for more than 3 months you are entitled to enter. **As a competitive swimming club we would like to encourage every swimmer to participate; this event is an important part of the training cycle. The event is also great FUN!**

6. Again, this year we have decided to incorporate a bonus point for each championship. Swimmers that enter 5 events per championship will receive a bonus point. (8&U's will receive an additional point if they enter all 4 events) This bonus point will be removed if a swimmer fails to compete in any entered event without a valid reason.
7. Any matter not covered by these conditions will be determined by the promoter of the competition and the referee subject to ASA laws, regulations and the ASA technical rules of racing. The promoter reserves the right to make changes that may be considered necessary for the smooth running and discipline of the event.
8. The promoter reserves the right to refuse admission to any spectator, coach or swimmer.
9. Results will be displayed throughout each session and on the club website as soon as possible after the meet. In addition, results will be e-mailed to British Swimming for inclusion in the National Ranking. Entries to this meet will be held on computer and consent to holding personal information as required by Data Protection Act 1998 will be deemed to have been given by the submission of the entry. Personal data will be available for inspection during the meet on application to the promoter.
10. Under ASA Child protection guidelines all spectators wishing to use cameras, video or digital capturing devices (including mobile phones) must first register their details on the forms provided at the spectator entrance. A wristband will be issued which must be shown at all times. This policy will be vigorously enforced and any person found to be contravening with this policy will be asked to leave the gala without a refund.

SPRINT CHAMPIONSHIP

Each age group (both male and female) will have an overall 1st 2nd and 3rd. This is based on the highest scored points over all 5 events (except 8 yrs & under which is based over 4 events) within each age group. Points for each event will be awarded as follows: - 1st - 5 points, 2nd - 4 points, 3rd - 3 points, 4th - 2 points, and 5th - 1 point. Awards will be given as follows, trophies for 1st and medals for 2nd and 3rd.

- 8 yrs & under - 25m swims - 4 events
- 10 yrs & under - 50m swims plus 100m IM - 5 events
- 12 yrs & under - 50m swims plus 100m IM - 5 events
- 14 yrs & under - 100m swims plus 100m IM - 5 events
- 16 yrs & under - 100m swims plus 100m IM - 5 events
- 17 yrs & over - 100m swims plus 100m IM - 5 events

HDW - All events are swum as heat declared winners. That is, everyone swims the event in heats and the points are decided from the times recorded for that overall **age group**.

Please note that the 50m sprints are optional for those that are 13& Over. These swims will be TIME ONLY and do not form part of the SPRINT CHAMPIONSHIPS.

MIDDLE DISTANCE CHAMPIONSHIPS

Each age group male and female will have an overall 1st 2nd and 3rd. This is based on the highest scored points over 4 out of the 6 events within each age group. Points will be awarded as follows 1st – 5 points, 2nd – 4 points, 3rd – 3 points, 4th – 2 points and 5th – 1 point.

STYLE TROPHY

This is where each competitor swims a 100m IM....this is not a race! Points are awarded for the style & technique of each stroke including starts & turns. The age groups are 8 & under, 10 & under, 11 to 14 and 15/Over.
